UC International Faculty-Led Study Abroad: Non-UC Applicants

September 2017

UC faculty-led study abroad programs are designed for UC degree-seeking students, but select programs will accept applications from non-UC students, at the discretion of the faculty leader.

To apply, non-UC applicants should:

- Meet for an in-person interview with the UC faculty leader.
- Complete the on-line application on UC International's webpage at <https://studyabroad.uc.edu/> for the program.
(Note: After "Apply Now" you will select "I do not have login credentials to this site.)
- Submit the [on-line basic data form](#) to apply to UC as a non-degree/non-matriculated student.
- Contact UC International at global@uc.edu via email, providing the following information and materials:
 - Your name
 - Name of the program to which you are applying
 - Status of completing the on-line application on UC International's webpage at <https://studyabroad.uc.edu/>
 - Status of completing the [on-line basic data form](#) to apply to UC as a non-degree/non-matriculated student
 - A copy of your college transcript(s)
 - Letter of recommendation from a faculty member at your home university
 - A statement from your home International Office supporting your participation in a UC faculty led program and the ability to accept transfer credits

If accepted, non-UC applicants will be required to register for the applicable UC course(s) via Catalyst. Please see the following link for using [Catalyst](#).
